
Pace of Play Clocks

Pace of Play Clocks

The slow play solution that will keep players at an acceptable pace of play and in accordance with golf's tradition of being a self managed etiquette sport.

The clocks are strategically placed at key holes and achieve the delicate balance between customer service and the issue of slow play. The clocks set the course's pace thereby improving everyone's enjoyment of the game.

How the Program Works

The golfer's only responsibility is to know his/her tee time. If the golfers are on the correct pace, the clocks will show their tee time throughout the round. Course management places the clocks at ideal locations and offsets each clock according to the course's pace of play. For example, management wants a "pace" that would have groups arrive at the 4th tee 45 minutes after they tee off, therefore the 4th tee clock is offset by 45 minutes. A foursome teeing off at 8:00 AM and maintaining their pace of play will arrive at the 4th tee in 45 minutes and the clock will show 8:00 am (their tee time). If 4 clocks are placed on the course and the group maintains their pace, they will see their exact tee time at each clock. If they are falling behind by 10 minutes, the clock will show 8:10 am and with a glance of the eye will know that they need to speed up.





Players Keep the Pace with a Glance of the Eye

The power and value of these clocks is that a foursome can easily self manage their pace. When they see the clock and it displays a time later than their tee time, they know they need to move a bit faster.

Our recommendation is 4-6 clocks (For example: 1st Tee, 2 on the front nine and 2 on the back nine) on the course to maintain the desired pace. You determine the best placement and time offset for your course based on your desired pace of play.

This approach is customer friendly and effective. Instead of putting one member of a foursome in the difficult position of coaxing another member to speed it up or a course ranger telling the group to speed it up, the clock becomes the reference, the standard, the motivation. Just as other sports have game clocks and are managed by time, this is the "Game Clock" for
